SOUTH AND BURRINGTON ROAD REPAIR PROJECT

The Select Board will conduct a Public Informational Meeting on the Proposed South and Burrington Road Repair Project on **Tuesday, July 16, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. at Sawyer Hall, Heath, MA.**

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING: To provide the public with an opportunity to become fully acquainted with the proposed project to repave South Road to Burrington Road to Charlemont line as well as improve shoulders along South Road near Community Hall. All views and comments made at the hearing will be reviewed and considered. The funds for this project to be acquired from a Small Town Road Assistance Grant (STRAP) Grant through the Executive Office of Housing and Economic Development. The grant will be written for **\$1,000,000**. The main purpose of the improvements is to enhance safety for commuter and emergency responders.

PROPOSAL: The proposed improvements are to reconstruct and resurface South Road from town center to Burrington Road to Charlemont line - approximately 3.1 miles and a 1 mile section of South Road to Bassett Road. The road will be upgraded using Cold in Place Recycling, Hot Mix Asphalt and culverts will be installed as needed. New catch basins will also be installed as needed. The ditches will be cleaned and repaired for proper drainage. The project will be completed with line painting and seeding of shoulders. All work on this project will be performed within existing right of ways. Traffic may be reduced to one lane and project should not impact emergency response vehicles.
