Taiji beginner's classes with Stan S. will begin on Feb. 5th from 3:00 to 4:30 in the cafeteria. The Scrapbooking workshop is tentatively set for Feb. 7th.

Senior Outreach: I've been making calls to seniors regarding the FRTA ride service, other senior programs/services, and giving my contact info, starting with the eldest residents and working my way through the list. I'll drop off transportation info for those who need it, so I would like to hold off a bit longer on a larger mailing. I would like to purchase postage for malings soon, using the funds provided by the town before the fiscal year ends.

Other: I will email everyone the article on Alice for the Herald to review and approve.

John Henry has offered to assist Heath seniors with Fuel Assistance realated questions and filling out the application. He has experience from working at Community Action, and was already able to help one senior family.

Based on the survey, I would like to focus next on what we can do to help with the isolation some of our residents are feeling.

I updated the COA page on the town website with Pat's help, and updated our COA info on the Lifepath website.

There is information from Project Bread on support for folks with food insecurity in the senior room and outside the library.
