Approved Minutes Joint Fincom/Selectboard Meeting 4 April 2023

Absent: Bob McGahan

Tom called meeting to order at 6:02 PM Alice arrived at 6:08 PM

1. 8.3 k for tree trimming cannot come out of Chapter 90 funds per fincom's inquiry. Chapter 90 funds are solely for road construction.

- 2. The selectboard is looking at the list of fincom asks regarding article 3.
- 3. There is an ongoing discussion regarding what to do about the town Accountant and software.
 - a. FRCOG does provide accounting help to member towns. Not clear how much.
- 4. Alice stated that we need 1.5k allocated for a software link between the assessors and tax collector.
- 5. Tom stated that as a goal, the town budget growth should not exceed 2 to 2.5% on an annual basis.
- 6. There was a lively discussion between the selectboard and fincom regarding the reduction from 4 to 3 full-time positions in the highway department.
 - a. Robyn will speak with Jeff Johnston (highway superintendent) tomorrow (5 April).
 - b. The selectboard will meet next week to decide
 - c. Robyn is recusing herself from the meeting next week due to a perceived conflict of interest.
- 7. Item 75 of article 3 (Town Nurse): Sue spoke to the town nurse...
 - a. Home services most needed
 - b. What services does FRCOG offer?
 - i. Annual home visit.
 - c. What about a clinic at 18 Jacobs Rd during library hours to target children?
 - d. Alice suggested that we budget nurse for 7 hrs per week (10,233.00/year).
- 8. Warrant discussion:
 - a. The Smith Vocational student from Heath might be returning to Mohawk Regional High School (items 9 and 10). Heath would still be responsible for prorated tuition for this year's tuition and transportation (items 12 and 13).
 - b. Item 17: small truck for highway department (194,512.00)
 - i. Brian is opposed to using Chapter 90 funds for this.
 - ii. We could finance with 85k from the vehicle stabilization account, some from free cash and the remainder financed.
 - c. Article 15 so far:
 - i. 65155.00 free cash
 - ii. 20k towards MTRSD error of 44k

- iii. 7.5k for audit stabilization account
- iv. 33k towards truck. Remainder could be borrowed.

Will made a motion to adjourn, Ned seconded. Fincom meeting adjourned at 8:49 PM.
