Sheila asked for help from Whip City Fiber in addressing the broadband needs of the customers planning to grow cannabis at 11 Bellor Road. Those customers want to reactivate the account at the house as a business account. The accounts for service elsewhere on the property will be new accounts. The plan is that the new accounts will serve trailers not yet in place.

Brian said that they can engage on what the customers need in the short term. Bill suggested that they might want a separate circuit for security.

Sheila asked whether ITG's builders' risk insurance would cover the materials and labor for the 216 cable that appear on the DocuSign CNST-20? Brian said he will ask Chris.

Sheila said that the pod is still at 18 Jacobs Road. Brian said that Chris had said it would be moved to some location in Mohawk Estates. Sheila suggested that Jenny be involved in choosing any new location in Mohawk Estates.

Bill asked whether Betsy could confirm for him that there are 23 active customers in FSA 4. Betsy checked her data and confirmed that.

David said that there are 68 new or pending for FSA 4 while there are 14 signed up but not activated in FSAs 1, 2, and 3. As for cold drops, there are 10 in FSA 4 and 12 in FSAs 1, 2, and 3.

The meeting adjourned at 1:45.
