 - b. Put together a plan to reduce use by 20%
 - i. No cost energy plan and list of things to do.
 - ii. No funding, just plan to reduce
- 4. BOS adopts a fuel efficiency policy, any vehicle under 8500 pounds must be fuel efficient.
- 5. All new buildings must be more efficient than usual. Enforced through a developing building codes. The "Stretch Code" says we should require a more insulation than normal? Also an extra consultant must be paid for to model the home or building. "Home Energy Rating Services" is the rating system used to measure energy efficiency.

216 communities have approved the Stretch Code in Mass.
