## HEATH CULTURAL COUNCIL ANNOUNCES 2024 GRANT RECIPIENTS Funding for community-oriented arts, humanities, and science programs allocated

The Heath Cultural Council (HCC) recently announced recipients of funding for the 2024 grant cycle. These grants were awarded in keeping with the Council's mission to support artistic and culturally enriching community programs in the Town of Heath and the sur- rounding area. This year, HCC received 20 grant applications.
